

Following are the guidelines for In-House Worship

- Worship is at 10:00 am.
- Entry into the building is through two entrances - either the west facing doors off the Memorial Garden near 1st Ave N or the east facing doors off 14th St N. The west facing doors off the Memorial Garden are easy access to the elevator and have a handicap opener.
- Hand sanitizer is encouraged upon entering worship.
- Masks are highly recommended for worship. If you have any flu-like symptoms, you are encouraged to attend online worship.
- Maintaining distance is strongly encouraged.
- Offerings may be placed in the offering plate at the back of the worship space. Offering plates are not passed through the pews.
- Holy Communion is celebrated each week by continuous line. Folks who wish may remain in their pew and the elements will be brought to you.
- Congregation drivers are not be picking up folks for worship.
- Worship service recordings are made available online as soon as possible at oslcgreatfalls.org under the “Media” tab. Printed sermons are mailed to those who request them. The 10:00 am worship service is also live-streamed on YouTube. More information is found on the “Media” tab of the website.
- Beverages and possibly a light snack are available following the 10:00 am worship service, along with a time of fellowship, downstairs (below the sanctuary) in Lunde Fellowship Hall. You may also feel welcome to take your beverages to the Memorial Garden to visit with one another. Masks are highly recommended as much as possible at Fellowship Time.
